

CHRONIC LYMPHOCYTIC LEUKEMIA (CLL) AWARENESS

SIGNS & SYMPTOMS OF CLL

In the beginning, CLL may not cause any signs or symptoms and may be found during a routine blood test. Later, signs and symptoms may occur. Check with your doctor if you have any of the following symptoms:



Painless swelling of the lymph nodes in the neck, underarm, stomach or groin



Feeling tired most of the time



Repeated infection



Fever and night sweats



Easy bruising or bleeding



Unexplained weight loss (without trying)

Most often, these symptoms are not due to cancer, but to other health problems, such as an ulcer or infection. Anyone who has these symptoms, especially if they do not go away, or even get worse, should see their doctor so that problems can be diagnosed and treated as early as possible.
