



SIGNS & SYMPTOMS

In the beginning, LPD may not cause any signs or symptoms and may be found during a routine examination or blood test. Chronic lymphocytic leukemia (CLL) may indeed present with a high white blood cell count, but no signs and symptoms. Later, signs and symptoms may occur.



Painless swelling of the lymph nodes in the neck, underarm, stomach, or groin



Feeling tired most of the time



Repeated infection



Fever and night sweats



Easy bruising or bleeding



Unexplained weight loss (without trying)
